Completing 1 ECTS credit from the course

The topics of the essays should relate to the 4APIs project's research themes <https://4apis.fi/work-package-sl/>, which are also the themes covered in the course presentations.

The groups will be formed and the topics are chosen and explored during the group sessions (afternoon part of the program).

All essays need to be returned by Apr 11, 2021.

Essays will go through an editorial process and collected into a Tampere university publication which will be publicly available. All essays need to meet the criteria for academic publication (plagiarism, references, style). Submitting your essay means you give permission to publish your essay as part of the publication. Editing and reviewing the essays will be handled by Osaango Oy.
